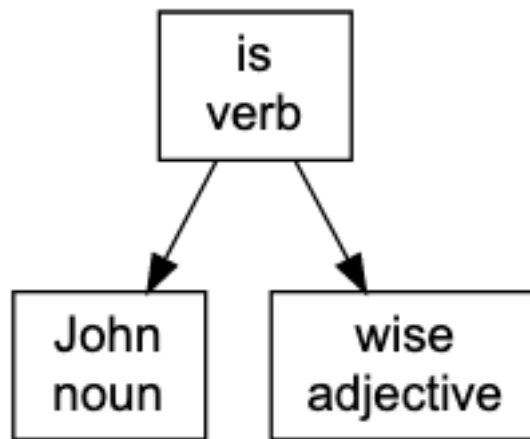
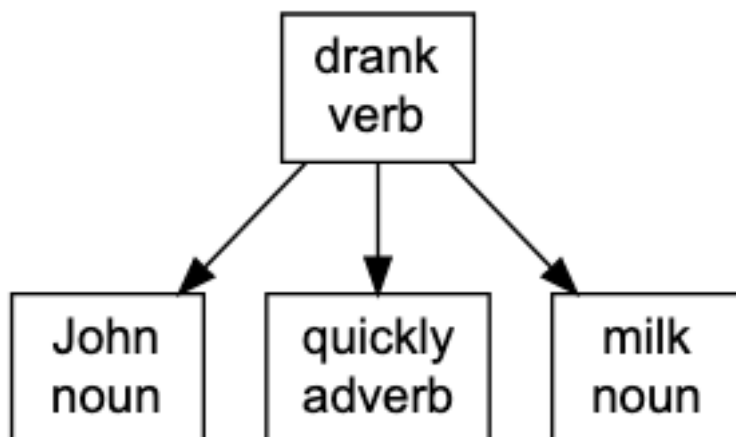

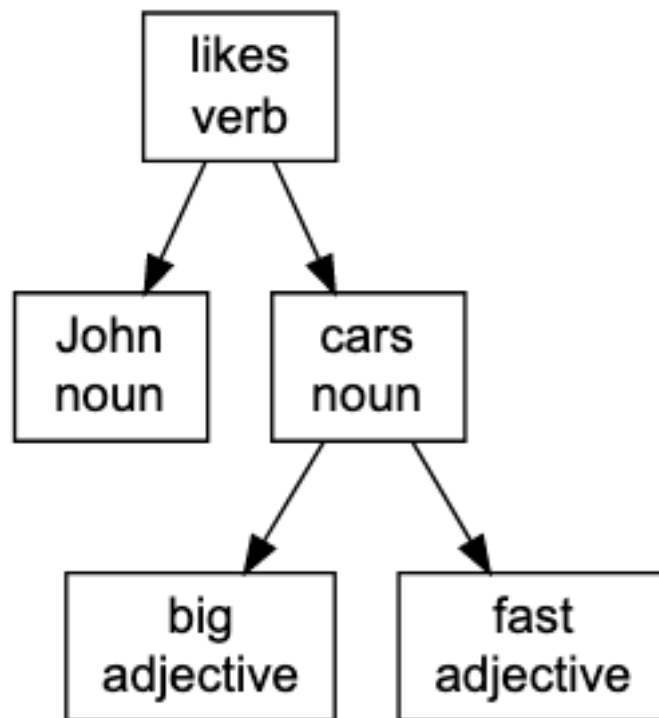
First sentence: John is wise.



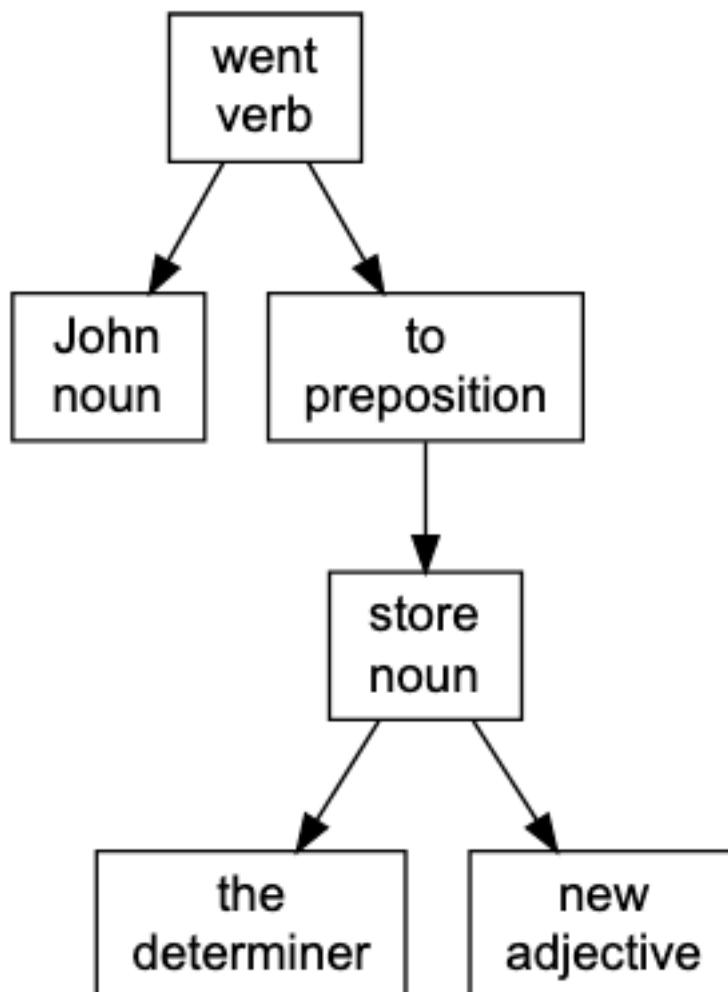
Second sentence: John quickly drank milk.



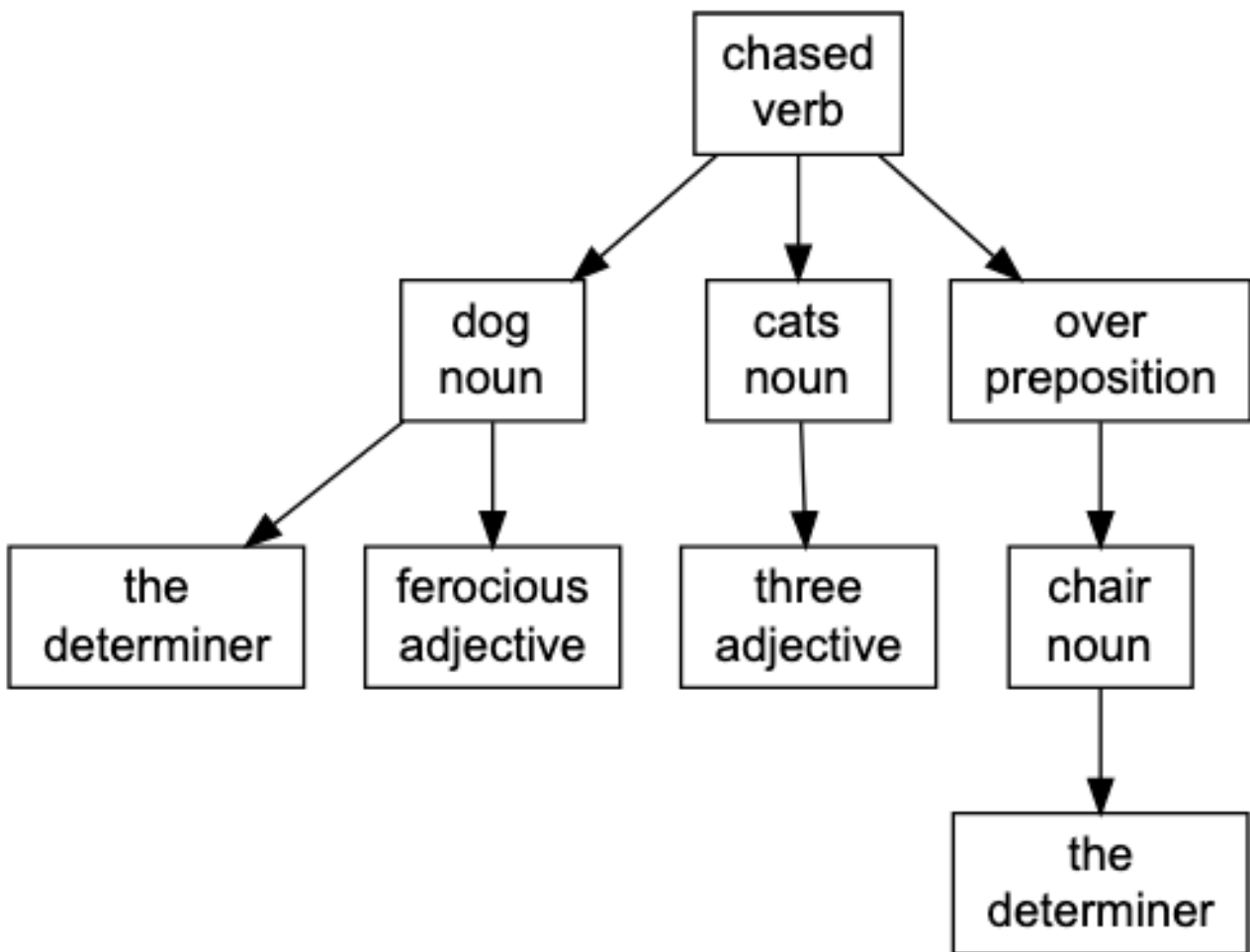
Third sentence: John likes big, fast cars.



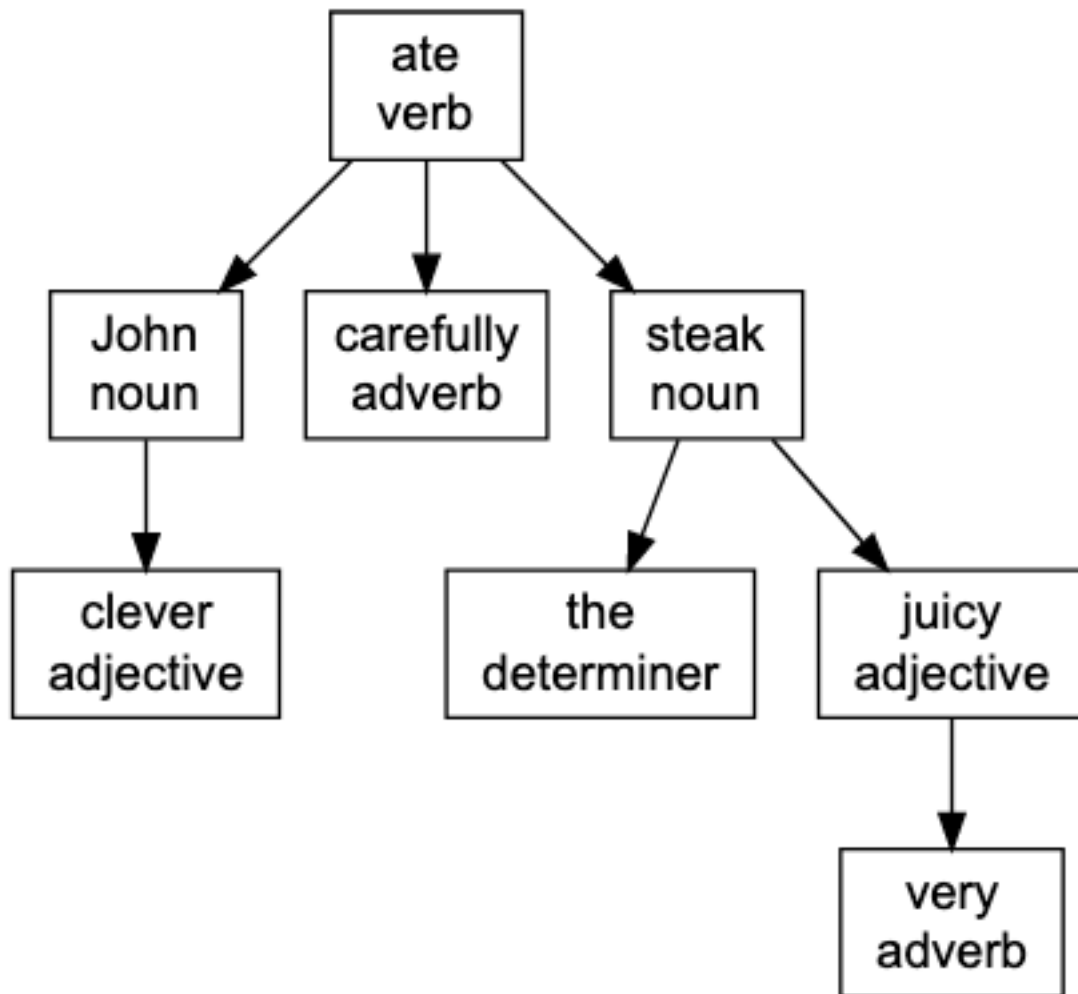
Fourth sentence: John went to the new store.



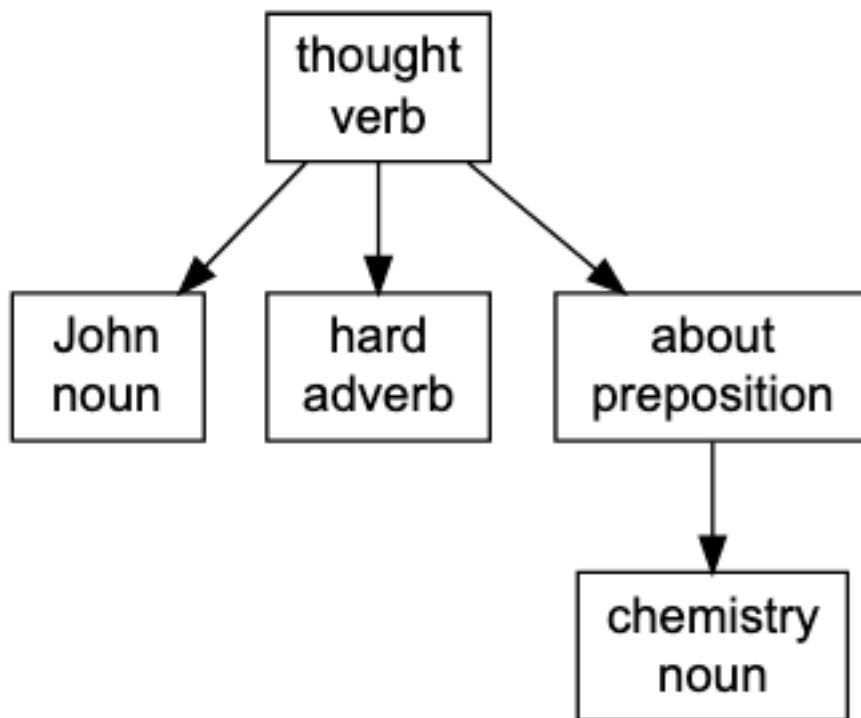
Fifth sentence: The ferocious dog chased three cats over the chair.



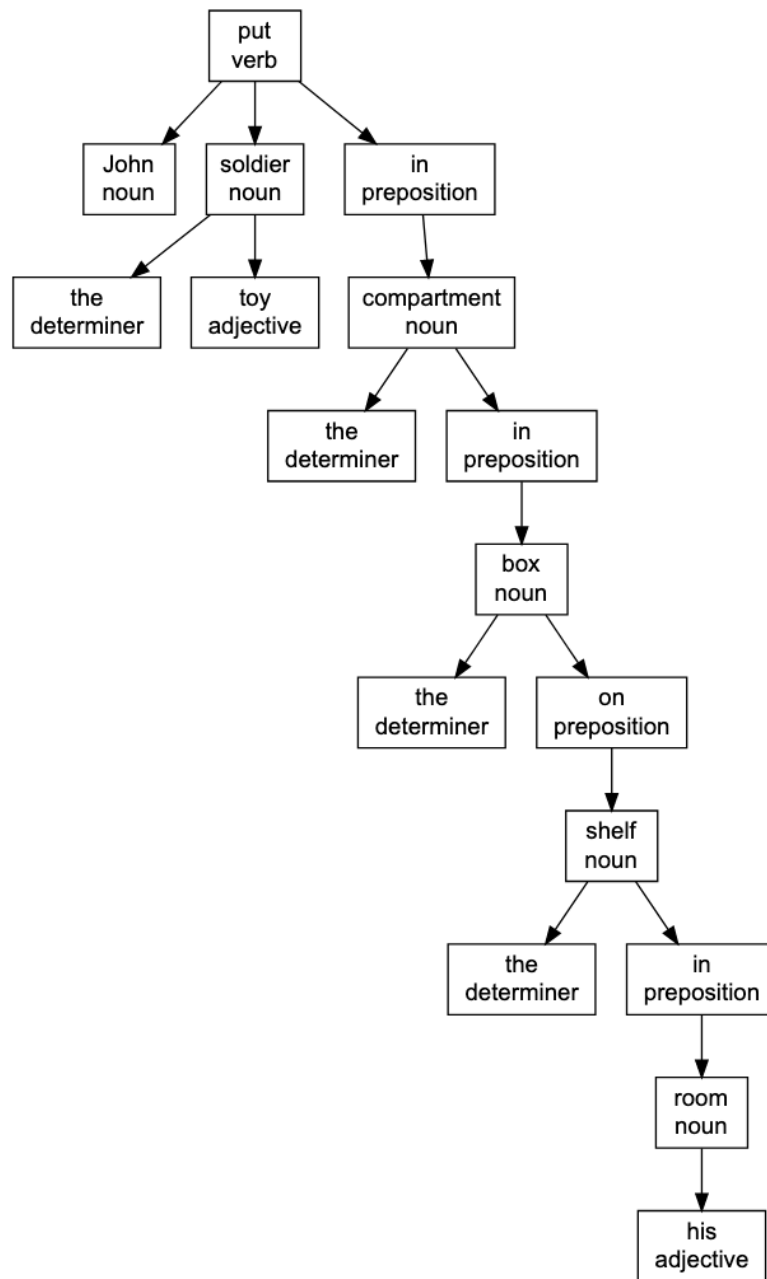
Sixth sentence: Clever John carefully ate the very juicy steak.
